## our mission

The mission of the WomenSchool of Ministry Leadership is to train leaders to advance God's kingdom by motivating, equipping and positioning women to minister effectively to individuals, the church and the world.

## why training?



Many women in ministry leadership have little or no training for the job. They often feel unskilled or unprepared for their ministries. Because of personal responsibilities, time and financial constraints, many are unable to seek out formal leadership and seminary education. If the church is to fulfill Christ's mission, women—usually the majority of a congregation—need excellent training to increase their competence and effectiveness in ministry.

## accessible and applicable

WSML is designed to put significant training within reach of most women. Six units of instruction are offered on three Saturdays annually over a two-year period. Classes are taught by seminary and college professors. To strengthen the learning experience, practical homework assignments and the support of a coach augment classroom work. An internship project also helps women apply their training.

## certification

Students attending the six classroom units and successfully completing all assignments and an internship will receive a certificate of graduation from WSML. These students may miss no more than two units of on-site classroom instruction to maintain enrollment in the school. Tuition is due even if you miss a class, in which case you will have access to the taped class session. Assignments are graded on a simple pass/fail or complete/incomplete basis.

## tuition and fees

**Certification-Track Students:** Tuition is \$75 per unit. This covers one Saturday's class instruction, handouts, lunch, coffee breaks and coach's input. Cost of textbooks and other learning tools is not included, but are minimal.

**Auditing Students:** Tuition for auditing students is \$65 per unit. Auditing students are not assigned a coach and will not receive certification at the end of the six units.
