



- ◆ The above Church-Led Mission Model begins with Church One or, C-1.
- ◆ The C-1 follows her God-given passion to a Nation or People Group.
- ◆ It returns with the needs of the Nation or People Group, who have said, "Would you please come and Help us."
- ◆ C-1 "recruits or empowers other churches C-2 through C-4 to assist in meeting the International Needs, and may recruit the para-church expertise of P-1 to do the same.
- ◆ The Converge District serves the churches by supporting their mission ministries and may recruit additional churches, identified as C-5 and C-6 to get involved. The District may choose to work with C-1 to develop an Executive Mission Team with efforts directed toward the stated Nation or People Group.
- ◆ Both the District and International Home Office provide communication both in the district and nationwide, along with additional training in missions, funds and support to build mission teams.
- ◆ The IM Home Office Primarily provides the R.A.D. (Recruitment, Assessment and Deployment) of Short Term Missionaries (Six months to 2 years) of service or Career Missionaries. The IM HO works through the District Office to solicit financial support of her missionaries who are considering short term or career missions.

Local-Global Initiative Roll out

1. Identify like minded congregations
2. Meet with mission committees and introduce the Local-Global concept
3. Identify and promote involvement in current sites.
4. Develop new sites and C1 churches.
5. Maximize partnerships.
6. Manage sites.
